In collaboration with Reggio Children and with support from the Canadian Association for Young Children, the Ontario Reggio Association is organizing a **Canadian study group in Reggio Emilia from March 27 – April 1, 2011**. The primary focus of the week will be

Pedagogical Documentation – Making Learning Visible.

The program will give visibility to the values of the philosophy through a combination of visits to schools, presentations, meetings and exchanges of experiences. Large group sessions will be balanced with smaller ones.

The Study Group program includes:

- history of the Reggio Emilia educational project and projections toward the future
- visits to preschools and infant-toddler centers of the Municipality of Reggio Emilia *Istituzione*
- presentations/seminars by pedagogistas, teachers and atelieristas on the values and principles of the Reggio philosophy
- presentations of research projects carried out in the Reggio Emilia infant-toddler centers and preschools
- time and space to interact with other participants and Reggio educators on specific occasions when opportunities will be given to dialogue and exchange experiences and reflections
- cultural encounters within the city of Reggio Emilia

The cost of registration will be \$1,700 CDN, with discounts offered for early registration and for members of CAYC and ORA. Half of this amount must be paid by November 23 with the remainder due by February 8.
